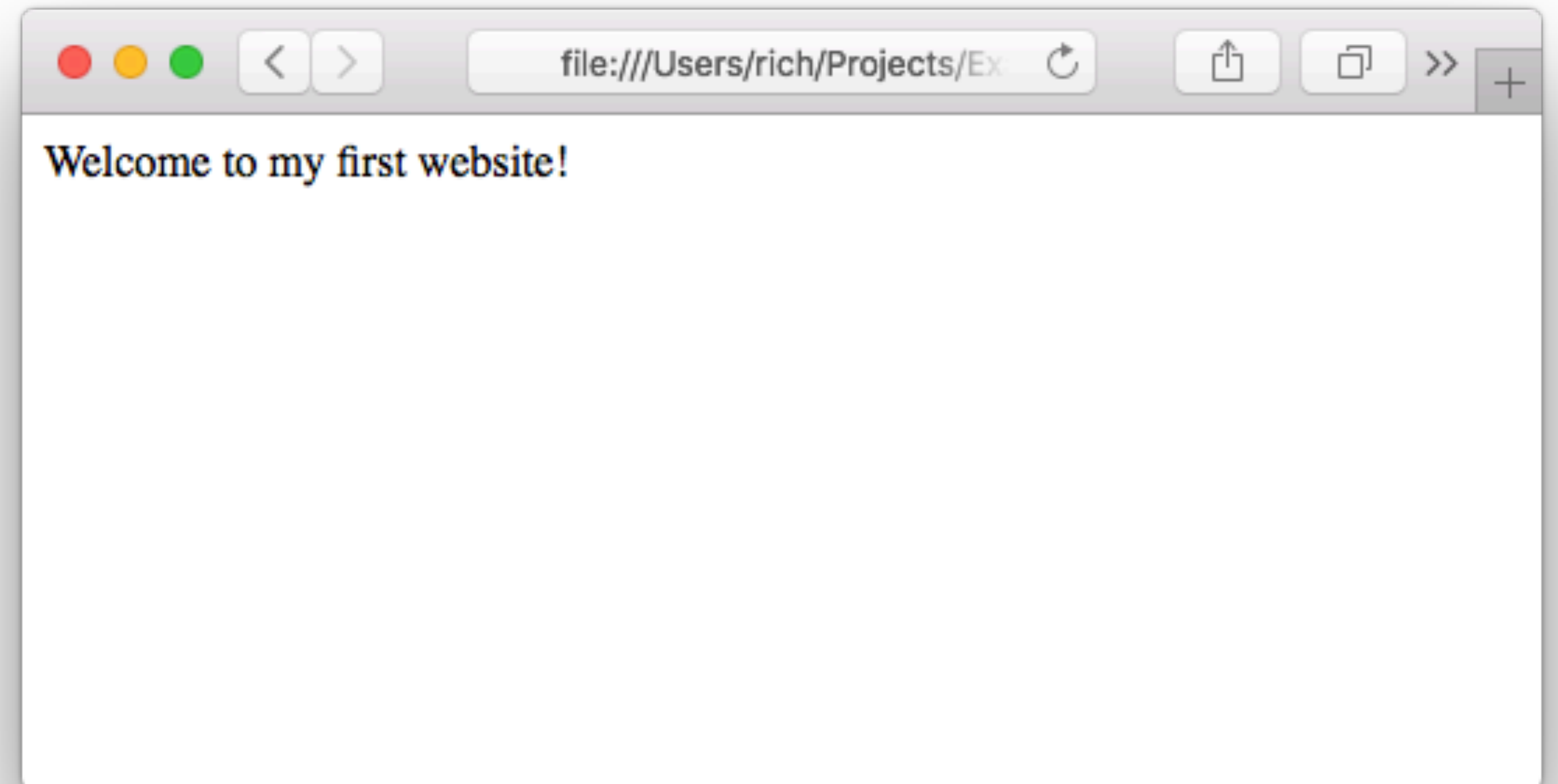

HTML, CSS, and JavaScript

- This is how your website is actually built.
- If you're using a website builder you don't need to worry about this.
- HTML is for page structure - text, links, images.
- CSS is how the page looks to the user
- JavaScript is for more advanced scripting and user interaction features.

- Google search for "Free HTML Templates" shows hundreds of results
- CSS Libraries: Bootstrap (<http://getbootstrap.com>), others.



Domain Names

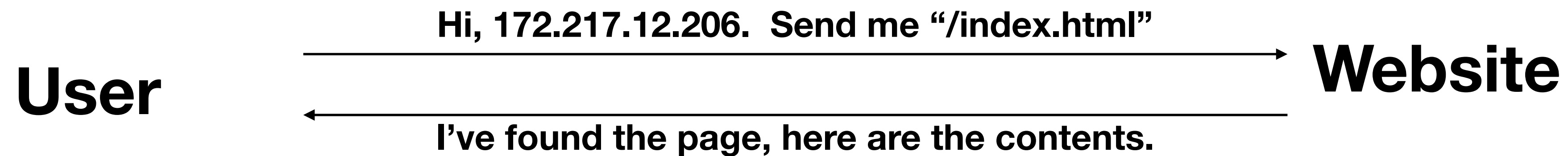
...because it's difficult to remember 172.217.12.206

What is a Domain Name?

- A human readable name for example google.com, that maps to an ip address, such as 172.217.12.206.
- This lets us visit websites much more easily.
- Register from a domain name provider such as Google Domains, Namecheap, or others.
- For a yearly fee, you can point your domain name to a website of your choosing.
- DNS is a core internet technology that is extremely complex.

Visiting a Webpage

Hosting Providers

- Sites Like [squarespace.com](https://www.squarespace.com), [wix.com](https://www.wix.com), [weebly.com](https://www.weebly.com) let you build from templates. Tumblr also offers a way to customize templates as well.
- Sites such as [godaddy.com](https://www.godaddy.com) also provide templates, but have options for users to customize your website using technologies such as PHP.
- AWS (Amazon Web Services) and Microsoft's Azure are a commercial-grade web hosting solutions. You can build websites and services that can handle large amounts of traffic for cheap, but you'll need to build and set up everything yourself. My website costs <\$0.05/month.
